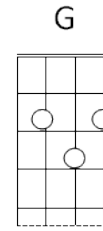


Fernando (ABBA) for ukulele Level 15

Key: G (Recording Key= A)



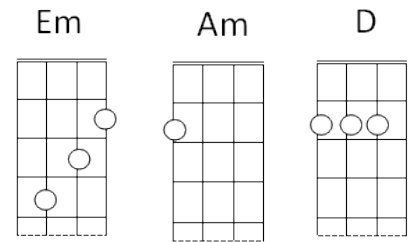
*Starting note: ^ (B)

I could hear the distant drums, and sounds of bugle calls were coming from a-far.

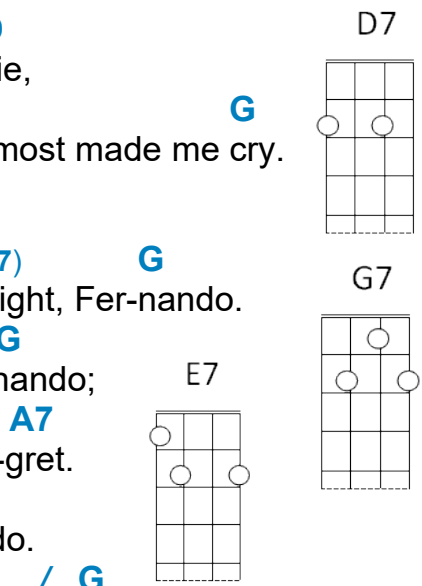
2. - They were closer now Fer-nando,

 And I'm not ashamed to say the roar of guns and cannons almost made me cry.

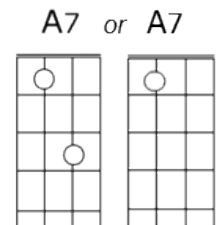
CHORUS:
